FamilySearch users are now required to create a free account to access records. On the December 24, 2017 ExtremeGenes podcast FamilySearch chief genealogical officer David Rencher explained the reason behind the need to set up a free account and log in. "So this is not about revenue, this is about contractual obligations that we have with our guys throughout the world. We're now in an electronic format rather than a microfilm format. ... They're requiring us to be able to identify users of their records." The login will give users online access to more images from mainly European records."
