### **Using Estate Files on FamilySearch**

During our research project on the Edge families of Maple Ridge/Langley I had the chance to use different records found at <a href="https://familysearch.org/">https://familysearch.org/</a>

While looking for a death record for Samuel Edge at the BC Archives I searched their vital events index and found no record for him. I decided to use their advanced search function in the archives database at <a href="http://search-bcarchives.royalbcmuseum.bc.ca/">http://search-bcarchives.royalbcmuseum.bc.ca/</a> and found a file for Samuel Edge in the New Westminster Supreme Court probate/estate files in 1898. I copied down the information about his file which included the folio number 457.

Next, I went looking for estate files. It was while doing research on another family previously that I located the British Columbia Estate Files 1859-1949 <a href="https://familysearch.org/search/collection/2014768">https://familysearch.org/search/collection/2014768</a>. These records are not indexed yet but you are able to browse the files for information.

I viewed the BC estate file records and found a link to the New Westminster records. I clicked on the link to the Supreme Court files and it listed an estate file index from 1859–1949 with the same detailed information as the BC Archives as well as links to the actual records.

Next, I went looking for the estate file for Samuel Edge. I clicked on the link for the estate files from

1898-1903 which included file (folio) numbers 444-630. I was looking for folio number 457. I found that each file had a handwritten file number on it starting with the letter P. I searched the files until I found a number close to 457.

I was able to advance the pages by placing a page number in the box at the top left hand corner of the screen which shows how many pages are in these files. Then I scrolled through the records like you would use a microfilm reader until I found the one for Samuel. His file started at image 1002 of 3341 pages for this set of files.

The record confirmed I had the correct person named Samuel Edge based on the page which listed his next of kin. He died on December 3, 1898 at Cascade City, BC without a will so his son Elias took on the roll of executor and planned to pay his father's debts and distribute any money left to surviving family members. It also confirmed the information we found on the death of Samuel's wife in 1887. Had we not located this record, we may not have known when or where he died because his death was not registered in BC. After locating this information, a newspaper article was also found about his death in the local newspaper for the area.

Please note that while the records are listed to 1949 not all districts have files up to 1949. For New Westminster the files only go to 1927.

And if you have family who died in Saskatchewan or Manitoba you can search the fully indexed probate records also available at *FamilySearch*: Saskatchewan Probate Estate Files, 1887-1931 or Manitoba Probate Records 1871-1930.
