The Whonnock Train Station

You are on the trail of Billy Buckaroo. He was last seen north of the Ruskin train station, so that is your first stop. You ask the clerk behind the counter at the train station if she has seen Billy, she has! She doesn't have time to talk but she can give you a copy of his train ticket. Check out the ticket the clerk gives you, can you figure out where Billy is headed next?

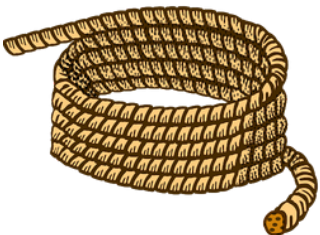

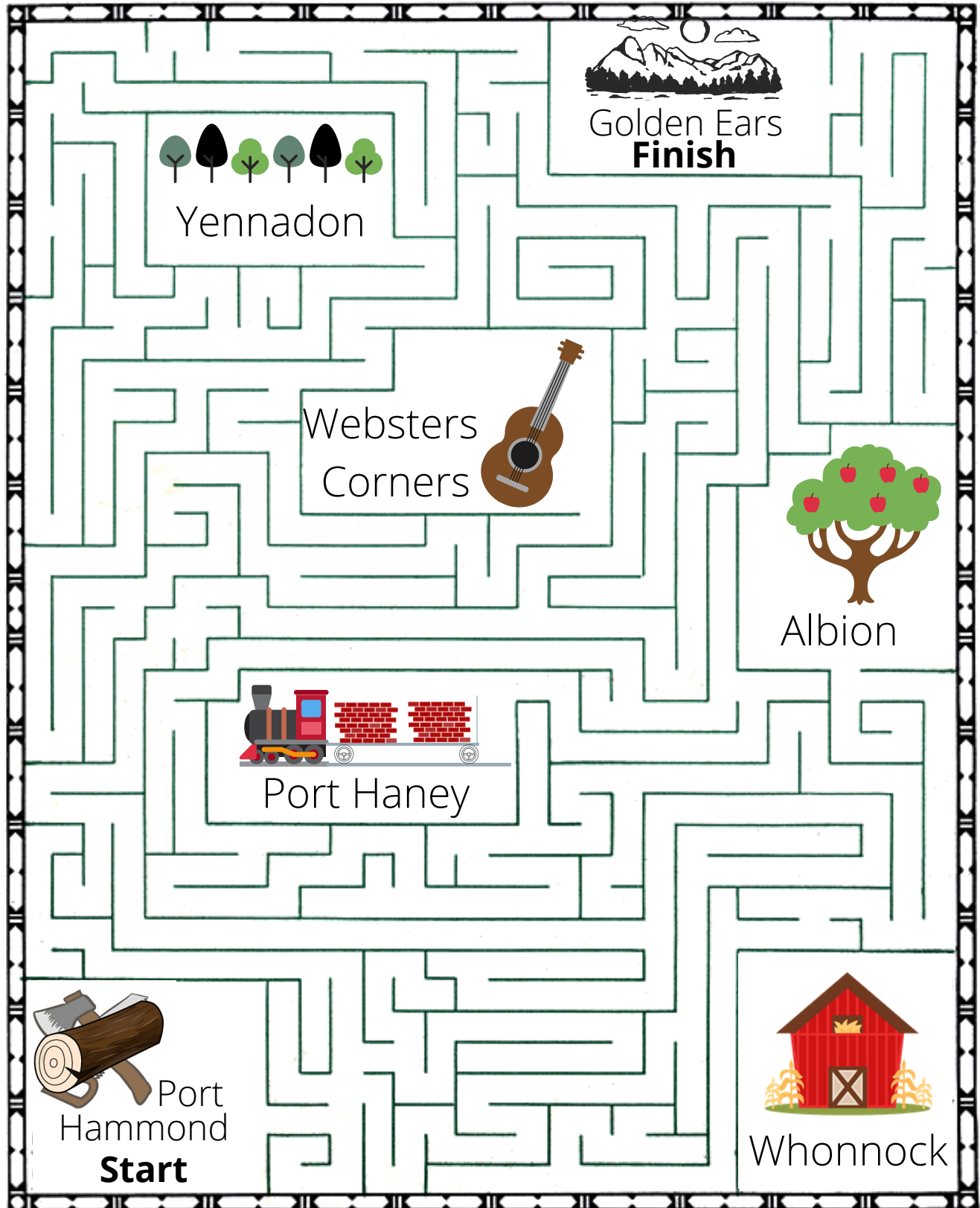
Local Map

Have a look at your attached map, think about what Billy just bought, where do you think he is going next?

The Golden Ears Mountains!

Follow the Map!

You start to head towards the Golden Ears Mountains where you think Billy Buckaroo is going. You have to take a winding path to get there since there are not many roads through the thick woods yet. Can you navigate through Maple Ridge's many neighborhoods to get to the mountains? Use the attached map to help you name the neighborhoods as you pass them.



In the Mountains

You follow his tracks up the Golden Ears Mountain, right to a spot on the ground that looks recently dug up. You begin to dig and find a locked wooden case. It is locked with a 4 number combination lock. Apparently Billy had a hard time remembering the combination so he wrote out a hint sheet, can you figure out the combination?

I went fishing and caught 16 fish but threw 9 back, how many fish did i have left?

$$16 - 9 = \mathbf{7}$$

I climbed the mountain and saw 5 geese, 3 bears, 2 skunks, 1 woodpecker, and three frogs, how many mammals did i see?

$$3 \text{ bears} + 2 \text{ skunks} = \mathbf{5} \text{ mammals}$$

I needed 3 canteens of water to climb the mountain, each canteen carries 3 pints, how many pints did I drink?

$$3 \times 3 = \mathbf{9}$$

Billy Miner and the gang stole \$10,000 from the train, we split the loot evenly, I got \$1,250. How many people made the heist?

$$10,000 / 1250 = \mathbf{8}$$
