
TIN CAN PHONE

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- TWO STANDARD SOUP CANS OR SIMILAR, WASHED, LABELS REMOVED
- NAIL
- HAMMER
- STRING 2-3 METRES IN LENGTH
- DARNING NEEDLE (OPTIONAL)



- USING THE HAMMER AND NAIL, CAREFULLY PUNCH A HOLE THROUGH THE MIDDLE OF THE BOTTOM OF EACH CAN.
- THREAD THE STRING THROUGH THE HOLE USING THE DARNING NEEDLE IF YOU HAVE ONE. TIE A KNOT AT THE END OF THE STRING ON THE INSIDE OF THE CAN. MAKE SURE THE KNOT IS LARGE ENOUGH THAT IT WON'T GO THROUGH THE HOLE WHEN PULLED TIGHT.
- REPEAT WITH THE OTHER CAN AND OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE STRING.
- TO USE: PULL THE STRING AS TIGHT AS POSSIBLE. ONE PERSON SPEAKS INTO THEIR CAN WHILE THE OTHER PERSON HOLDS THEIR CAN UP TO THEIR EAR.



TIN CAN PHONES WERE THE EARLIEST PHONES! THE INVENTION IS ATTRIBUTED TO ROBERT HOOKE IN THE 1660S. HOOKE WAS A PHYSICIST, ASTRONOMER, GEOLOGIST, METEOROLOGIST AND ARCHITECT.
