Howdy Sheriff! A no good outlaw is loose in Maple Ridge and it is your job to catch him, can you do it? Billy Buckaroo was part of Billy Miner's train robbing gang and we hear that he is back in town to stash his loot from the train robery. He has left clues in each part of town and you have to solve them to catch him. To start, make sure you have your sheriffs badge and thinking cap on, lets go!



Learning Outcomes

This activity will work, with educator supervision, for grades K-6. Younger students will require more help and older can likely make their way though with little supervision. Some activities can be modified to make them more difficult or easy depending on the grade level. The solutions to all puzzles can be found in separate PDF labeled as "Answers." Basic learning skills tested include:

- Critical thinking/Problem Solving
- Local History
- Local Geography/Map Reading
- Math problem solving
- Animal and item identification

Instructions

Start with the first task below and that will take you to the next and so on.

Some activities require the supplementary neighborhoods map, found with the PDF of this activity on the website. Each puzzle can be solved independently and does not necessarily require a correct answer to continue, but it does help with the continuity and mission feel.

The Whonnock Train Station

You are on the trail of Billy Buckaroo. He was last seen north of the Ruskin train station, so that is your first stop. You ask the clerk behind the counter at the train station if she has seen Billy, she has! She doesn't have time to talk but she can give you a copy of his train ticket. Check out the ticket the clerk gives you, can you figure out where Billy is headed next?

At the General Store








Have a look at your attached map, think about what Billy just bought, where do you think he is going next?
